Santa Monica Boulevard / Silver Spring Drive Traffic Signal Replacement and 14 Intersections

Please join us for a Public Information Meeting to discuss the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) Traffic Signal Replacement and 14 Intersection Project. The traffic signal at the intersection of Santa Monica Boulevard and Silver Spring Drive will be replaced. The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT), in conjunction with Village of Whitefish Bay are also providing safety improvements that address bicycles/pedestrian crashes and right-angle vehicle crashes at fourteen intersections and Silver Spring Drive Corridor in the Village of Whitefish Bay. LaLonde Contractors is the selected contractor for this work.

The meeting is scheduled for **Monday, August 12, from 4:00 PM to 5:00 PM**, at the Whitefish Bay Village Hall – 2nd Floor Village Board Room, 5300 North Marlborough Drive. Representatives of the contractor, Village of Whitefish Bay, WisDOT and the design / construction engineering team will be present to discuss the project and answer questions.

The proposed traffic signal improvements at Santa Monica Boulevard and Silver Spring Drive are intended to improve signal head visibility and pedestrian / bicycle safety at the intersection, while replacing outdated equipment. The proposed improvements include:

- New signal heads with 12" lenses on all indications
- New signal poles
- Overhead signal displays mounted to mast-arms for the east and west travel
- Reflective backplates on all signal heads
- New controller and cabinet
- Pedestrian countdown timers
- Pedestrian push buttons
- Vehicle detection

In addition there will be minor safety improvements (signage/striping) at the following locations:

- Henry Clay Street/Marlborough Drive - Intersection improvement.**
- Silver Spring Drive/Berkeley Boulevard - Intersection improvement.**
- Silver Spring Drive/Diversey Boulevard - Intersection improvement.**
- Silver Spring Drive/Hollywood Avenue - Intersection improvement.**
- Birch Avenue/Santa Monica Boulevard - Intersection improvement.**
- Cumberland Avenue/Oakland Avenue - Intersection improvements.**
- Hampton Road/Woodruff Avenue - Intersection Improvements.**
- Montclair Avenue/Santa Monica Boulevard - Intersection improvements.**
- Château Place/Sheffield Avenue - Curb ramp and intersection improvements.**
- Lexington Boulevard/Kimbark Place - Intersection improvements.**
- Chateau Place/Marlborough Drive - Intersection improvements.**
- Wilson Drive/Berkeley Boulevard - Curb ramp, island and intersection improvements.**
- Silver Spring Drive/Lydell Avenue - Intersection Improvements.**
- Silver Spring Corridor (Lydell Avenue - Marlborough Drive) - Lighting upgrade.**

Work on this project is expected to start at the **Santa Monica / Silver Spring intersection** the **week of Monday, August 12, 2019**. At various times throughout the project, single lane closures on Silver Spring Drive will be in place for the safety of the travelling public and the workers on the site. Contractor typical hours of operation are expected to be 7:00 am to 5:00 pm weekdays and possibly Saturdays.

The Whitefish Bay Public Works Department staff understands the inconvenience that this project creates for you and greatly appreciates your patience and understanding. **Please be careful, slow down and pay extra attention when driving around this and all construction zones.**
