Village of Whitefish Bay **2019 Utility Reconstruction Project**

The Village of Whitefish Bay Public Works Department is under contract with Globe Contractors to complete needed underground utility reconstruction work throughout the Village. The work will include both water main and sanitary main repairs on the following streets:

Watermain replacement work:	6100 block of N. Shoreland Avenue (north half)
Sanitary Sewer Main replacement work:	300 block of E. Carlisle Avenue
	100 block of E. Belle Avenue
	1100 block of E. Henry Clay Avenue
	Wilson Drive / Diversey Boulevard intersection

Following these needed utility repairs the affected pavement will be temporarily repaired with the permanent paving work being completed later this fall. Construction is scheduled to begin on N. Shoreland Avenue the **week of August 26, 2019** (weather permitting). The contractor has informed the Village that some equipment is expected to be moved onto N. Shoreland Avenue by Friday, August 23. Full project completion is scheduled for late September, weather permitting

Garbage Pick-up: Please continue to bring your refuse and recycling carts to the **street curb in front of your house** on your usual collection day by **7:00am** throughout the duration of this project. While placing your carts at the street curb, please space them a minimum of 3' apart and a minimum of 3' from other obstructions.

Where do I park if I cannot access my driveway on N. Shoreland Avenue? It is expected on most evenings you will have access to your driveway and garage. If that is not the case due to this construction project, we have enclosed two (2) parking permits that allow you to park overnight any private vehicles on any adjacent street for the duration of the project. Please place the parking permits in the **left corner of your rear window**. The Village of Whitefish Bay Police Department has been notified of this project. If you need additional passes please contact Spencer Charczuk below.

The Public Works Department staff understands the inconvenience that this project creates for you and greatly appreciates your patience and understanding. **Please be careful, slow down and pay extra attention when driving around this and all construction zones.**
